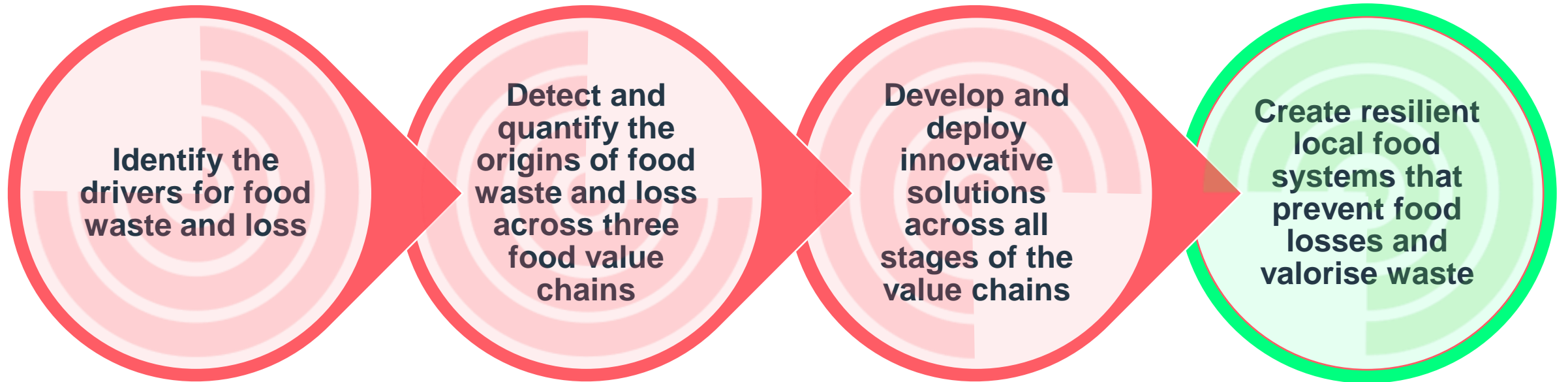

**29 partners** representing educational institutions, companies, networks, industry associations and not-for-profits



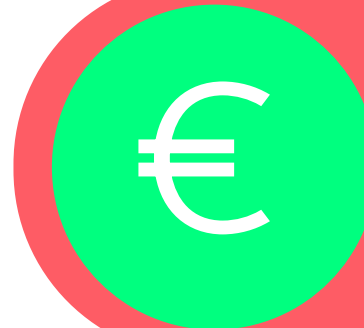

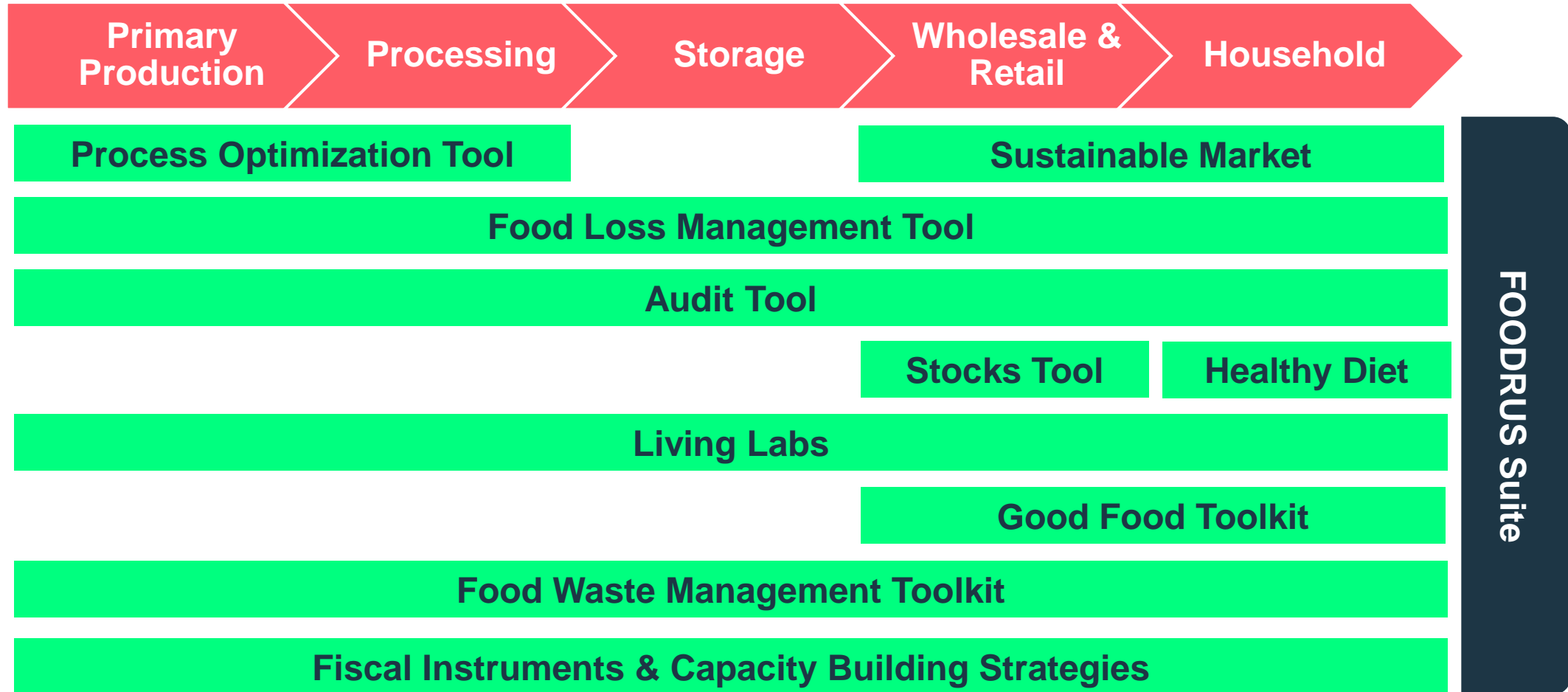

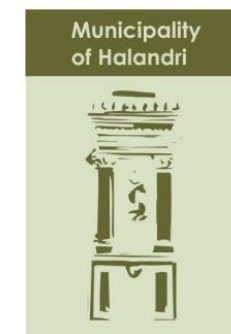
